The purpose of the APPG	The attendees agree the purpose of the APPG will be to identify how best e-scooters and e-bikes should be regulated to help decarbonise transport and provide low-cost transport options while protecting pedestrians and other road users.

Attendees agreed the call for evidence could hear evidence on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accessibility</li> <li>• Licensing</li> <li>• Regulatory framework</li> <li>• Illegal vs trial e-scooters</li> <li>• Street clutter and parking</li> </ul> <p>Attendees discussed the possibility of focusing on off-road mobility but agreed this fell outside the scope of the APPG.</p> <p>In addition to this approach, attendees agreed on other networking events such as a summer networking reception.</p>
